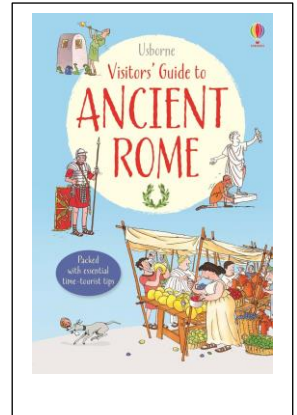

What should I know already?

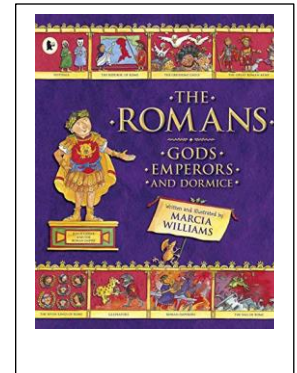
- That Roman are from the past.

Key Vocabulary	
Gladiator	- (in ancient Rome) a man trained to fight with weapons against other men or wild animals in an arena.
Conquer	- to overcome and take control of (a place or people) by military force.
Empire	- an extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single monarch, an oligarchy, or a sovereign state.
Emperor	- a sovereign ruler of an empire.
Colosseum	- a large theatre, cinema, or stadium
Amphitheatre	- (especially in Greek and Roman architecture) an open circular or oval building with a central space surrounded by tiers of seats for spectators, for the presentation of dramatic or sporting events
Legion	- a large section of the roman army, made up of 5000 solders.

What will I know by the end of the unit?

- By the end of this Topic, children will know where romans fit into the British history timeline.
- They will know that they were in England before the Anglio-Saxons and Vikings.
- They will know that they were good solders.
- They will know about gladiators and what they did for entertainment.
