Key Vocabulary	
Gladiator	<ul> <li>(in ancient Rome) a man trained to fight with weapons against other men or wild animals in an arena.</li> </ul>
Conquer	<ul> <li>to overcome and take control of (a place or people) by military force.</li> </ul>
Empire	<ul> <li>an extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single monarch, an oligarchy, or a sovereign state.</li> </ul>
Emperor	- a sovereign ruler of an empire.
Colosseum	- a large theatre, cinema, or stadium
Amphitheatre	<ul> <li>(especially in Greek and Roman architecture) an open circular or oval building with a central space surrounded by tiers of seats for spectators, for the presentation of dramatic or sporting events</li> </ul>
Legion	<ul> <li>a large section of the roman army, made up of 5000 solders.</li> </ul>
