Key Vocabulary	
Gladiator	 (in ancient Rome) a man trained to fight with weapons against other men or wild animals in an arena.
Conquer	 to overcome and take control of (a place or people) by military force.
Empire	 an extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single monarch, an oligarchy, or a sovereign state.
Emperor	- a sovereign ruler of an empire.
Colosseum	- a large theatre, cinema, or stadium
Amphitheatre	 (especially in Greek and Roman architecture) an open circular or oval building with a central space surrounded by tiers of seats for spectators, for the presentation of dramatic or sporting events
Legion	 a large section of the roman army, made up of 5000 solders.
