INTRODUCTION/ WELCOME

DP started the meeting with outlining our LAP Trust vision and values and the vision for the school. Christian values. Beliefs and missions explained. Feedback AH not all new as been in trust before. DH communication not so strong. AH DM transition ok.

1.1 CHRISTIAN VALUES

DP – importance of underpinning all our work on core Christian values. Raising the profile of spiritual development and Christian distinctiveness is a priority for the school.

GP & AH stated school stripped of all values - they were there. GP IP not had positive experiences with change of trust, no closure. Devastated. Karate reading mentioned. Parent survey 23 replies - not seen by some parents. DP reassures the survey was on newsletters to guage parent voice on vision and values. 70% not know Christian values.

1.2 COMMUNICATION

AH number attending as communication had broke down historically. For example DM unable to locate today's meeting.

What works best – Class Dojo: AH not updated enough, old staff still visible. ACTION: Class Dojo needs to be tidied up. (Admin old staff removed)

DM asked about Tapestry: learning just Owl class. Download for parents at the end of YR. ES not had Tapestry. JS & DH to check parent access.

1.3 | CLASS STRUCTURE FOR 23/24

DP – current model is not working. Year groups mixed and peer groups separated. Complicated. Needs to be simpler.

AH how?

Models have been created and communicated for approval. Key stage/ numbers taken into consideration. Possible model could be -

R, Y1/2, Y3/4, Y5, Y6

GP – older child. Mature – struggled. Bored. Works a year above. Capable. Feels isolated.

DP Opportunity to learn together in peer group so important. Learning DM parent worry about with friends. Compared to being a 'family'.

DM class names questioned. Why do we need bird names? GP, AH positive.

Wake & Shake – parents miss it. DP - Timetable change explained and learning time maximised. Physical activity occurs each day in many forms. DM liked whole school together. Relationships built.

DP confirmed about learning gaps and why times changed. Morning minds are more receptive to learn. CW all get together first thing.

Parents agreed no need to change.

Playtime – issues sorted. GP Structured approach is much better.

1.4 LOOKING FORWARD

DP – Curriculum development and enrichment – SIP curriculum. Maths, reading, teacher development. Children will get the best offer possible. Enrichment – trips, sports events.

Music, drama. Bringing alive. GP wind turbine visit. Honey company/Bees summer term. Visitors in school very popular. ES – pony in. (therapy pony)

1.5 AOB
