

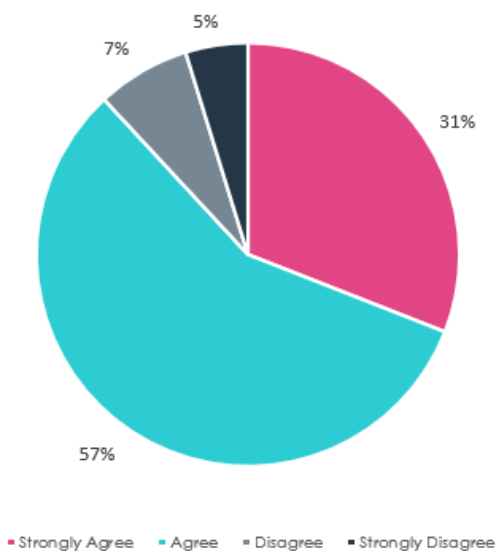

## My child is happy at a Trust school

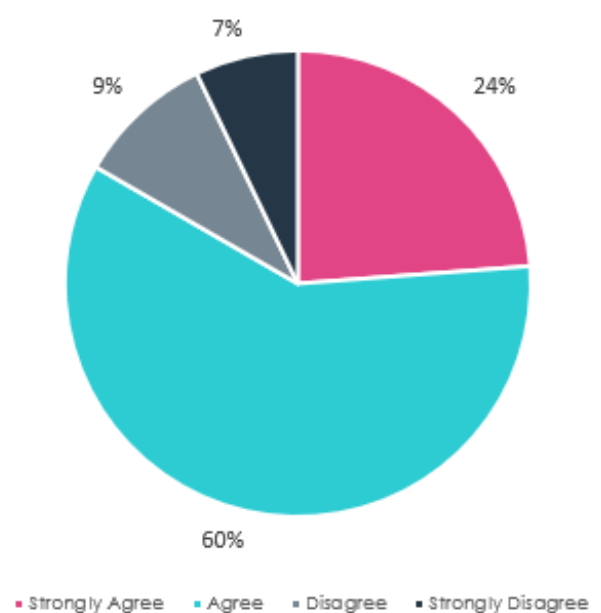

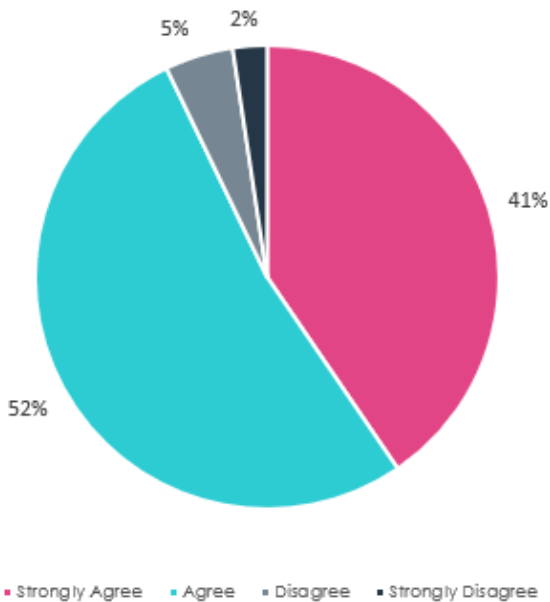
## The school's ethos and culture have a positive effect on my child

**My child feels safe at school**

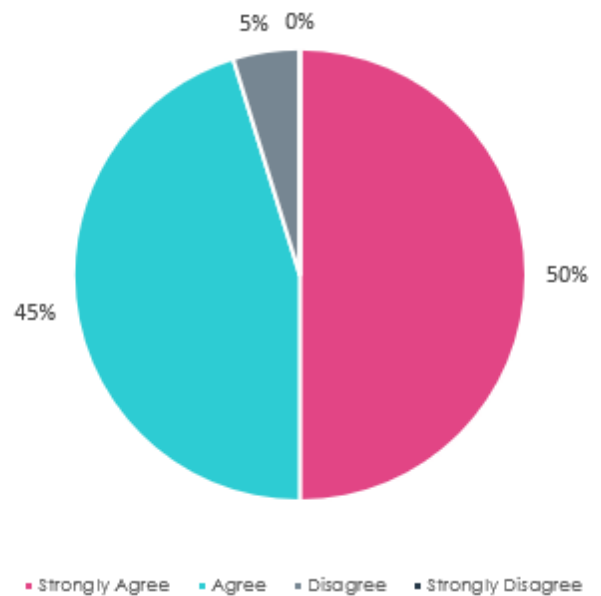


*“ My child has never felt unsafe at school which has a good effect on her learning.”*

*“ The buddy system especially and the interaction between year groups here is very nurturing and creates a lovely whole-school community.”*

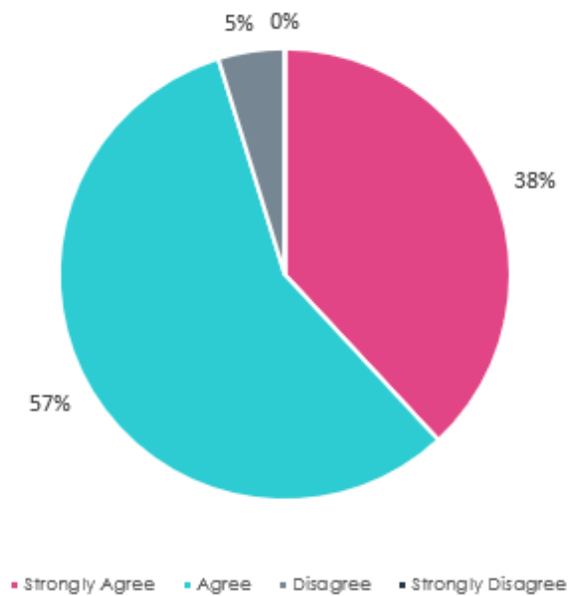
**The school encourages its children to be respectful and caring**



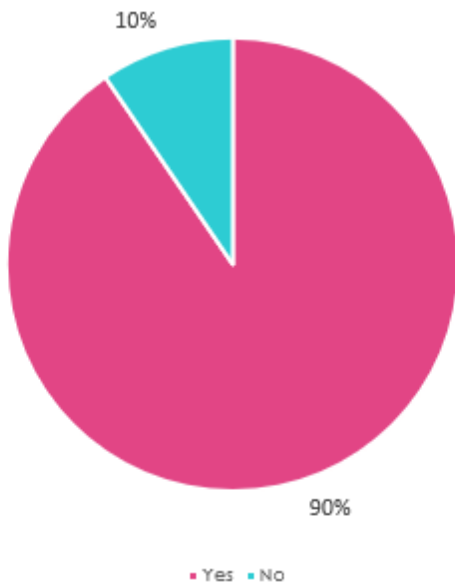

*“The children seem to be respectful and caring to each other and the school environment .”*

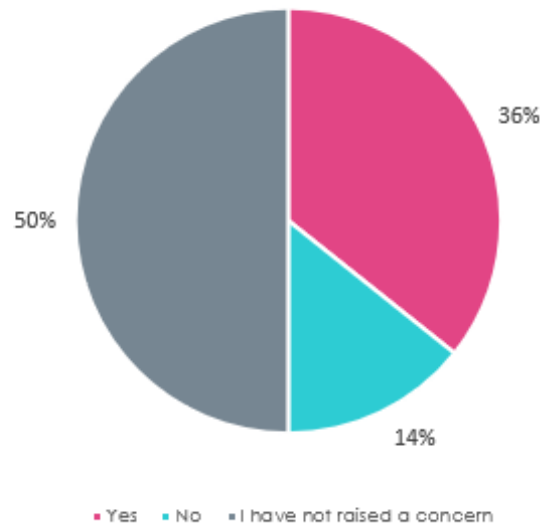
**The school ensures its children are well behaved**



**The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year**



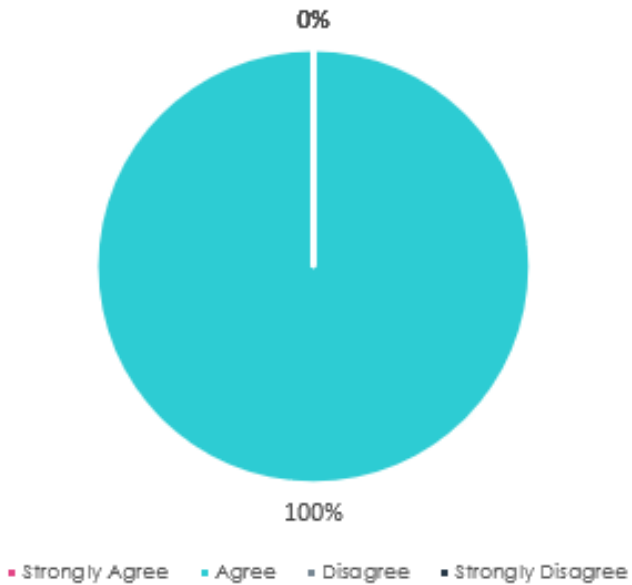
**When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with in line with our complaints policy**

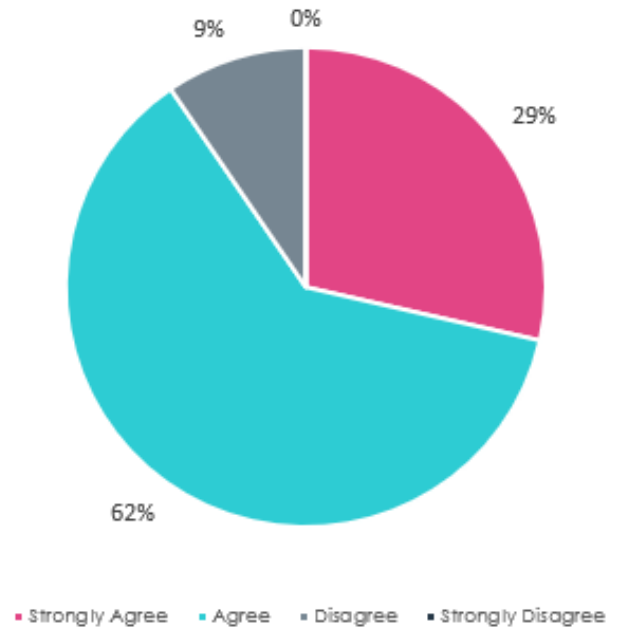
How strongly do you agree with this statement? "My child has SEND and the school gives them the support they need to



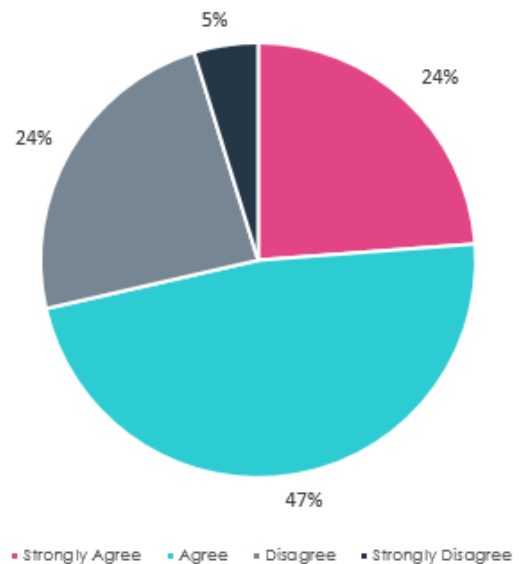
*"The opportunities with which they are provided as well as the space they explore their own interests, is a clear sign that the school respects the children as individuals and expects them to achieve great things."*



The school has high expectations for my child



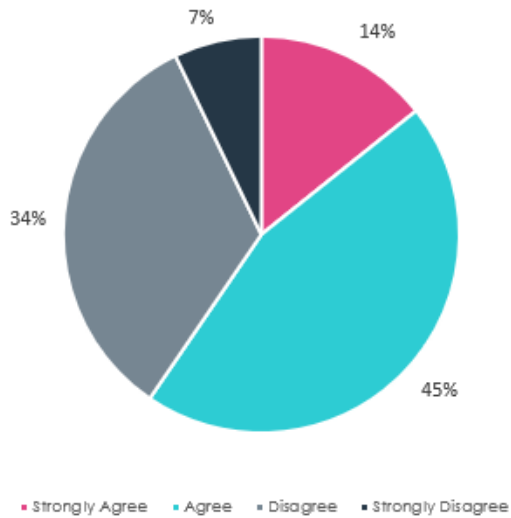
My child is flourishing at school

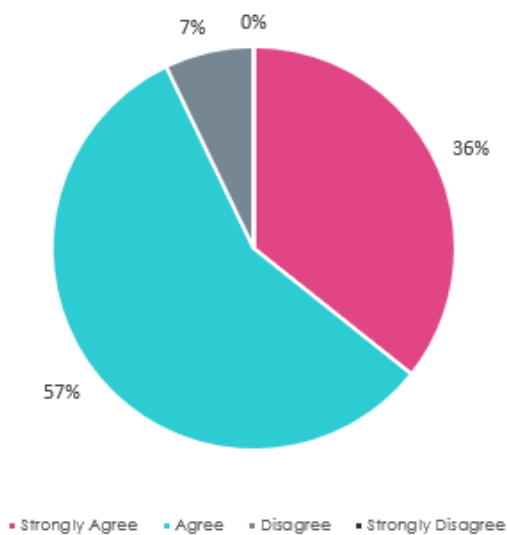

The school lets me know how my child is doing

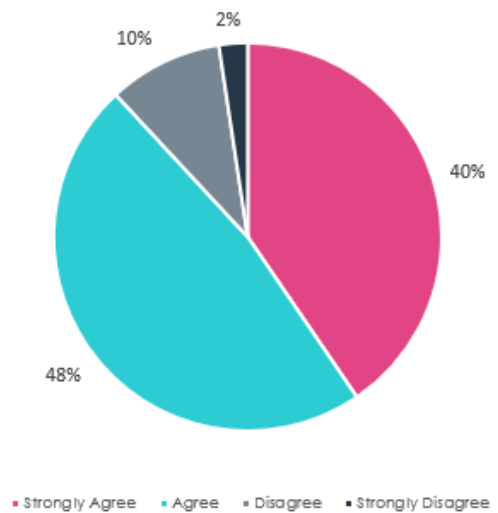


*“There have been many activities lately that has been wonderful for the children. School trips/beach school ,clubs and much more. I feel very pleased with it.”*
