<p>Reading</p> <p>As readers, we will have daily Phonic lessons using the Read, Write, Inc. scheme. The children will learn new sounds daily and read stories to match their reading ability. Please continue to support the children with their reading through phonics and record this in your child's reading record 5 times a week. We also have a daily 'Talk through Stories' session where children learn a new story for that week and explore new vocabulary and key phrases. Our whole class text is 'Charlotte's web' by E.B. White</p>	<p>Writing</p> <p>As writers, we will write simple sentences using capital letters, full stops, neat handwriting and finger spaces. We will ensure our spellings match our phonic ability and we will transfer this to our writing. We will focus on spelling the common exception words appropriate for our year group. We will learn to be independent at using resources and word mats available. We will begin in yr 2 to write different genres of text and develop our writing skills.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>As mathematicians, we will explore multiplication and division and use this knowledge to understand the concept of fractions. We will also be learning the language of position and direction of shapes and objects. In yr 1 we will develop our understanding of place value up to 100. In yr 2 we will be looking at statistics and how we use different graphs and charts to represent information.</p>
<p>RE</p> <p>In RE, we will investigate religious festivals, ceremonies and rituals and will be able to talk about the beliefs behind them. We will be able to talk about belonging and how different faith groups are similar and different to one another. Our focus this term is learning about the Gospel of Jesus. Our core Christian values are COMPASSION and COURAGE this term and so we will be learning more about living our values.</p>	 <p>PUFFIN class Termly Curriculum Overview Summer term 2024</p>	<p>PSHE</p> <p>In PSHE, we will look at 'Keeping myself safe' and 'Growing and changing.' In these units, we will discuss the importance of being healthy and how to be safe online. We will also look at how to recognise when words and behaviours are inappropriate and how to get help with this.</p>
<p>Geography</p> <p>As geographers, we will be able to recognise, locate and describe the locations of the seven continents and five oceans. We will be learning about each one and how to use maps and atlases to find places and identify physical features of each one.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>As scientists, we will be able to describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of foods, and hygiene. We will also be learning to identify and classify carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores. We will carry out investigations and experiments and learn how to record results and observations and make scientific evaluations.</p>	<p>History</p> <p>As historians we will question our understanding of the past, inspiring a curiosity to learn about the society in which we live. We will learn about events beyond living memory. We will learn about the events of and after the Great Fire of London and examine sources of evidence to learn about the lives of the people affected.</p>
<p>Art</p> <p>As artists this term, we will complete a unit of work on the works by Eric Carle. We will learn the skills and techniques that he used to create his artwork and use this to design and create their own.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>As digital citizens, we will be looking at the technology that can be found around us. We will focus on learning how to use a word processor and create a piece of text using different keys and functions.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>As musicians, we will be able to find and keep a steady beat. We will explore the tempo of different pieces of music and describe this as fast or slow. We will also learn songs and develop our singing voice. As musicians, we will be able to understand how to compose and perform with others.</p>
<p>D.T.</p> <p>As designers and constructors, we will learn how to use textiles to design and create their own glove puppet. We will explore the different skills and techniques needed to sew and make their own finished product.</p>	<p>Outdoor learning</p> <p>We will be learning to recognise and understand the need to look after and become caretakers of our immediate environment and understand how this will impact on the wider world.</p>	<p>PE/ Sport</p> <p>In PE we will be learning to develop coordination and control as well as mastering skills needed for all athletic activities. They will also learn skills needed to take part in striking and fielding activities and games.</p>
