| Reading<br>As readers, we will be exploring a variety of non-fiction texts<br>relating to our Science topic 'Bright Sparks' and various poems<br>linked to our other curriculum areas. We will also be reading<br>'Truckers' by Terry Pratchett, and 'The Dog Who Saved the World'<br>by Ross Welford as our class read this half term.<br>Please listen to your child read as often as possible and talk to<br>them about what they read to help build up a deeper<br>understanding. | Writing<br>As writers, we will be developing our composition skills and<br>language choices through our sentence stacking writing approach.<br>We will build up a rich reservoir of language, practise writing<br>together and then implement our skills into independent pieces.<br>We will use 'The Boy, The Mole, The Fox and The Horse' by Charlie<br>Macksey, 'I Believe in Unicorns' by Michael Morpurgo, 'The<br>Wizards of Once' by Cressida Cowell and 'The Snowman' by<br>Raymond Briggs for our writing sequences this term. | Maths<br>As mathematicians, we will explore place value, the four<br>operations and fractions. We will also be practising our timetables<br>every day to help with fluency.<br>Please remember to practise at home on Times Table Rockstars.  |
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| <b>RE</b><br>In R.E. this term, we will be answering these BIG questions:<br>'Creation and Science: conflicting or complementary?' and 'Why<br>do Christians believe Jesus was the Messiah?'.<br>We will explore the creation story and Christian thoughts as well<br>as Scientific thoughts on the creation of the world.<br>Our core Christian values are RESPECT and FREINDSHIP this term<br>and so we will be learning more about living our values.                              | CHOUGH class Termly Curriculum Overview<br>Autumn term 2024   | <b>PSHE</b><br>In PSHE, we will look at relationships, exploring friendships and<br>working collaboratively with others. We will find out what good<br>communication looks like and how to be a good team leader. Later<br>in the term, we will investigate differences and how these should<br>be valued. We will discuss stereotypes and segregation as well as<br>how we are stronger together and united. |
| <b>Geography</b><br>As geographers, we are working to answer this BIG question: How<br>has Bude's physical features changed in the last 100 years?<br>We will explore the physical geography of Bude and compare<br>features and explain changes over time. We will look closely at<br>Bude's coastline and how this has changed over the past 100<br>years as well as how it is predicted to changed in the future and<br>what could do to help protect Bude.                        | Science<br>As scientists, we will be investigating light and electricity. We will<br>explore how light travels and what colours it is made up of. We<br>will investigate light using periscopes, mirrors, torches and other<br>reflective surfaces. We will explore electricity and how a circuit<br>works. We will also investigate renewable energy electrical<br>hazards and electrical conductors and insulators.   | History<br>As Historians, we will be working to answer the question; 'What<br>impact did World War II have on Cornwall?'<br>We will discover the role Cornwall played in the second world war,<br>how the county changed during this time and the preparations for<br>the D-Day Normandy landings.  |
| Art<br>As artists this term, we will explore the work of David Hockney. By<br>the end of the unit, we will have recreated a Hockney piece and<br>created our own originals in the style of Hockney's vibrant, surreal<br>style. In the second half of the term, we will design our own<br>electrical games using circuit components.  | <b>Computing</b><br>As digital citizens, we will explore systems and how they work, as<br>well as how search engines store and rank search results. We will<br>look closely at search engines and find out how they can be used<br>effectively and appropriately. In the second half of the term, we<br>will create some stop motion videos in our 'creating media' unit.   | Music<br>As musicians, we will focus on 'Make You Feel My Love' by Adele.<br>We will listen and appraise, sing and play instruments to explore<br>pulse, rhythm and pitch within the focus song. We will also learn<br>to play, improvise and compose sections of the focus song. In<br>addition, we will learn to sing as a choir, focus on Christmas carols<br>towards the end of the term.                 |
