## What should I know already?

- To explain connections between biblical texts and Christian ideas of God, using theological terms.
- To make clear connections between Bible texts studied and what Christians believe about God; for example how churches are designed.
- To show how Christians put their beliefs into practice in worship.
- To weigh up how biblical ideas and teachings about God as holy and loving, might make a difference in the world today, developing insights of their own.

# Key Vocabulary

Omnipotent	Having unlimited power.
Omniscient	All knowing.
Eternal	Lasting or existing forever, without end.
Holy	Morally and spiritually excellent.
Commandment	A divine rule, especially one of the Ten Commandments.
Parable	A simple story used to illustrate a moral or spiritual lesson, as told by Jesus in the Gospels.
Gospel	The teaching or revelation of Christ.
Bible	The Christian scriptures, consisting of the Old and New Testaments.
Sermon	A talk on a religious or moral subject, especially one given during a church service and based on a passage from the Bible.
Miracle	An extraordinary and welcome event that is not explicable by natural or scientific laws and is therefore attributed to a divine agency.
